3 Science Credits	2 Credits of Arts/ Humanities
3 Math Credits	3.6 Credits in any other elective
4 years of Phys Ed (1.6 Credits)	Successful completion of a Graduation Project

Freshman (Grade 9) need to schedule 5.6 Credits (Passing 4.0 credits to promote to 10th) Sophomores (Grade 10) need to schedule 5.6 Credits (Passing 9.0 credits to Promote to 11th) Juniors (Grade 11) need to schedule 6.0 Credits (Passing 15.0 credits to Promote to 12th) Seniors (Grade 12) need to schedule 5.4 Credits (Passing 21 credits to Graduate)
