- July 2 – July 9, 2020 – Individual District Pandemic Meetings to develop template. (i.e. School Nurses, Administration, Transportation, Building and Grounds, Food Service, Information Technology).
- July 10, 2020 – Wayne Highlands School District, Wallenpaupack Area School District and Western Wayne met to develop common plan
- July 13 – July 14, 2020 – Continued District Pandemic Meetings to develop template.
- July 15, 2020 – Met with Wayne Memorial Hospital, Wayne/Pike Department of Health, Wayne/Pike Emergency Management Directors, Wallenpaupack Area School District, Delaware Valley School District and Western Wayne School District to review common plan.

---


- 1,802 surveys completed with a 2,402 projected enrollment for the 2020-21 school year
- 75% response rate
- To best serve our students, parents were asked to complete the survey for every child in their household as the responses may be different depending on each child's age, grade, and needs.









1,802 responses




- Yes, my child would get a school lunch




- I will arrange transportation for my child.














## (Extra-Curricular Activities)
